Snowmobile & Winter Rescue Squad Member

This person is responsible for:

- Being available to drive the department snowmobile and rescue sled to location of the patient
- Stabilizing the patient using “First Responder” skills: ABC’s (Airway, Breathing, Circulation, severe bleeding)
- Administering oxygen to the patient as needed
- Applying Cervical Spine stabilization collars, properly belting patients to a backboard and securing them in the rescue sled
- Monitoring patients during transport to the ambulance
- Assisting ambulance personnel with patient transport
- Restocking medical supplies for the next call
- Making sure that the snowmobile and sled is always ready for an emergency
- Becoming trained and remaining familiar with radio and phone communication and protocols
(USFS, Medical Control at the base hospital, and CDF)
- Completing Patient Care Reports (PCR) for calls

Requirements:

- Will be available (and in safe physical condition to respond) in the event of an emergency
- Will pass a criminal records check
- Will pass the first responder course and have a current BLS or Professional Rescuer CPR card
- Will attend annual training sessions for first responder, CPR, and snowmobile rescue operations
- Will remain current by driving the snowmobile with rescue sled monthly during the winter
- Remain in compliance with all HLVFD standard operating guidelines (attached)
